## Provide First Aid in an education and care setting



### Course Description

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies.

### Entry requirements

There are no entry requirements. However, participants must have the physical capacity to perform the practical demonstrations e.g. 2 mins of uninterrupted CPR on the floor.

Students maybe required to undertake online pre-course work prior to attending the face to face session depending on the delivery mode.

Online study students must have access to computer, smartphone, tablet with access to internet to complete the online/pre-course study.

### Statement of Attainment

Students who will demonstrate competency in all assessments will received statement of attainment for:

- HLTAID012 Provide First Aid in an education and care setting
- HLTAID011 Provide First Aid
- HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

### Delivery

Face to face delivery will include 1 day (8.5hrs) of training in small groups.

Blended delivery will include half a day (4 hrs) training in small groups requires 4 hours of pre-learning done online.
